

\$2,000 Per Year to Help Students in the Construction Trades



Carl A. Bongiovanni

Carl A. Bongiovanni was a lifelong resident of Allegheny County, and continuously involved with his community in a number of capacities. He was the owner and president of Bon Tool Company, presently in Gibsonia, PA, from 1994 until his sudden passing on January 26, 2017.

The Carl A. Bongiovanni Scholarship was made possible by the outpouring of love and donations from his friends and family with the guidance and support of the Pittsburgh North Optimist Foundation (PNOF). The purpose of this scholarship is to provide a student with funding for continuing their education in the building / construction trades at a post-secondary institution. The scholarship is worth \$2,000 / year, sent directly to the educational institution, for as long as the student is enrolled in the program (maximum of 3 years). The scholarship will be awarded during the finalist's institution's award ceremony or some other relevant event/function.

Eligibility:

- The applicant must be a senior high school student enrolled at an approved vocational or career and technical school, and looking to continue their education in one of the following trades: Carpentry, Construction Management, Drywall/Lathing, Electrician, Horticulture, HVACR, Ironworking, Masonry, Plumbing, Construction Trades (or equivalent program), Welding
- The applicant must maintain a 2.5 GPA or better
- If accepted, the recipient must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA for the duration of the scholarship
- The applicant must complete the attached application form and essay (applications can be completed electronically or mailed in see Page 6)
